• **Providing a clean, safe environment for you is our #1 priority.**



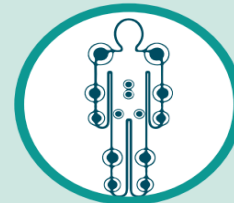

Gloves are not recommended over thorough hand washing unless they are requested by clients or required by authorities. If used, gloves shall be changed before and after touching clients and after contact with any soiled or unsterilized tools and surroundings.



The new normal . . .

- The last 45 minutes of class will be spent on disinfecting your work area and items.
- If you exit the building you will have to go through the re-entry process, no exceptions.
- Its recommended you have your lunch delivered via a delivery food app or bring your lunch with you from home.
- The 15 minute break will be strictly enforced.
- No lingering around, all students must leave when class is over.

STUDENTS RETURNING ON CAMPUS

- As students return to campus, the distance learning class for that program will no longer be an available .
- Students that don't feel comfortable returning to campus will have the option to take an LOA.
- June 1st. - all Phase I students

- June 15th – cosmos and esthis
